



## Boris Pikovsky

November 5, 1947 - July 10, 2022

Boris Beniaminovich Pikovsky, 74 of Mason, Ohio passed away peacefully on July 10th, 2022. He was a beloved son, brother, father and grandfather, greatly admired by his family and close friends.

Born in Kiev, Ukraine, Boris battled a hearing disability to achieve professional success and receive accolades for his talents in computing and technology. He received a degree from the National Technical University of Ukraine Polytechnic Institute where he taught computer courses to other students. He went on to become one of the top engineers at Radiozavod, widely recognised for innovative approaches to his work.

Boris was a loving and devoted partner to his late wife Larisa, who bravely immigrated with him and their children, Marina and Alex, to the United States in 1991 as refugees. They built a vibrant life together in Ohio, surrounded by family, friends and the Jewish Russian speaking community. Boris' loyal son Alex lived with him and cared for him through his last days and they shared many interests and hobbies.

Boris will be remembered for his kindness, his easy-going attitude, his generosity of spirit, and his infinite selflessness. No ask from any person close to him was ever too much for him to take on, and he did so with joy.

He loved cooking, researching new recipes, reading and collecting books. A passionate sports fan, who was a keen footballer throughout his youth, he supported many teams from Dynamo Kiev to Reds, Bengals, Cavaliers, Bearcats, and Bluejackets. He enjoyed traveling on adventures with his family,

from visiting his grandparents in Chopoviche to exploring the United Kingdom with his own grandson, Daniel.

Boris will be laid to rest beside his beloved wife Larisa in a Jewish cemetery in the United Kingdom near his daughter, son-in-law and grandson, all of whom he adored.
