March 30, 1935 - May 1, 2024

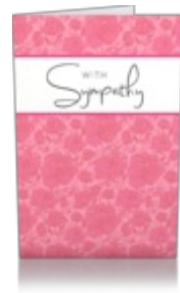
Charles Alan Rosenblatt
