Don was born and raised in Dayton, Ohio where he lived until he was twelve years old at which time he and his mother moved the family to Cincinnati. Don graduated from the University Of Cincinnati College Of Pharmacy and graduated in 1956. During college, Don apprenticed at Horwitz and Plotnick Pharmacies. From 1957 until 1969, he practiced with Ackerman (aka Mt. Carmel Pharmacy). Don joined the staff of (Frank) Kunkel Pharmacies in 1969, first serving the needs of Mercy Mariemont Hospital and then being selected as Director of Pharmacy. Don served the hospital for twenty years until 1989 at which time he took a position with Thriftway, the Drug Emporium in 1994; and CVS in 2003. Recently retired, Don served with the U.S. Army Reserve from 1957-62 reaching the rank of Staff Sergeant.
