Edith maintained a life-long interest in the fine arts and culture, and was an inveterate traveler, enjoying trips to Alaska, China, Europe, India, Israel and Russia.

Edith began her career in the Import-Export division of Union Commerce Bank in Cleveland, and later became the Executive Director of the Lorain County Development Committee until it was dissolved in the late 1970's, whereupon she held positions in the Elyria City Prosecutor's Office and the Elyria City Income Tax Office.

She was active in Elyria's Community Concert Association, the League of Women's Voters, Hadassah, and the Sisterhood of Temple B'nai Abraham in Elyria.
