ROSIN, Elaine, M.D., neé Youkilis, age 81, passed away June 20, 2022, daughter of the late Paul Youkilis and Dorah Dorfman Youkilis, wife of the late Lewis Rosin and in later years a beloved companion of the late Harold Wagner, devoted mother of Paul Rosin of Florida, Julie (David Meranus) Rosin, and Marci Rosin, dear sister of the late Mel Youkilis and Linda Buntoff Youkilis, loving grandmother of Jessica, Ashley and Becky Rosin, also survived by many loving nieces, nephews and cousins.

Elaine can best be remembered for her passion and love of medicine. As a Cincinnati native, she prided herself on her education and schooling. She was a graduate of the Walnut Hills High School, attended the University of Michigan as an undergraduate and went on to earn her degree in medicine at the Ohio State University College of Medicine in 1965. Elaine further went on to specialize in the field of cardiology. A true pioneer of her time, she became one of the first female doctors in Cincinnati to specialize in internal medicine and cardiology. She practiced medicine for over 30 years serving her patients in the Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky community. Elaine enjoyed her retirement years traveling, boating, gardening, reading a countless number of books and spending time in her second home in Boca Raton, Florida.
