Eleanor Megel died peacefully at Hospice of Cincinnati in the evening of June 25, 2010, after a long and gallant battle with cancer. Born May 3, 1926, she was the daughter of Fannie Lustig Sitzman and Marcus Sitzman of Vienna, Austria.
