Elisheva grew up in Israel and served in her country's Security Forces rising to the rank of colonel. She came to the United States in 1979, ran an international business and organizational consulting practice before retiring. Then she worked as a psychotherapist in private practice and pastoral counselor.

Elisheva was the Shophet (leader) of Am HaAretz (AMHA) a nature/earth oriented Israeli tradition that reconnects to the spirituality of ancient Hebrews before rabbinical monotheism. She has written books on Israeli Earth Spirituality and has lectured extensively on the topic.

Her academic background is archaeology at the Tel Aviv University, interpreting at the Interpreting School of Milan, and counseling at the University of Cincinnati. Her interests included sailing, camping, traveling, and various crafts.

She is survived by Victor, her husband of 50 years, and by great many friends and students.

On Thursday, January 5, 2023 funeral services will be held at 10am at the Weil Kahn Funeral Home. Interment will follow at the Heritage Acres Cemetery. Refreshments will then be provided at the house of Elisheva and Victor, 4144 State Line Rd, Okeana, OH, 45053. 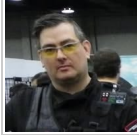
