Dr. Errol J Stern, MD saved my life by performing a very complex surgery on my L4-L5 destroyed lumbar area of my spine. February 2001 was the date and the Jewish hospital in Cincinnati was the location of the Emergency Surgery where I was rescued when my herniated disc unexpectedly ruptured.



Pre and post spinal laminectomy care was also carefully managed by Dr. Stern and his staff at Tri—state Orthopedics as well as the Dr. Daniel Drake Center for post acute care in Norwood, Ohio and Cincinnati, Ohio, respectfully.

Coincidentally, I attended The Walnut Hills High School in Cincinnati, Ohio with classmate, Michelle Stern, who was very beautiful and kind very much like her father. And Michelle was a mentor to me 20 years before I met her father. At the time of knowing Dr. Errol Stern, MD I had no idea that he was related to Michelle Stern.

I thank them both for so many great and wonderful memories and I am so sorry that Dr. Stern passed away at such a young age. He brought so many smiles to my face and used my medical chart as a teaching opportunity in his line of work. Everyone in Cincinnati recognize him as an expert physician..

I also thank my outstanding and beautiful parents Mayor Richard F. and Lorene Verdell Hunter. I was born with many orthopedic challenges and their tender and loving care from day 1 always made me feel safe through many surgeries and challenges starting before age 5.

In death, 2008, my astute mother, a 35 year Cincinnati, public school, instructor, donated her body to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center in honor of her dedication to the medical field and legacy of Dr. Daniel Drake, MD.
