CINCINNATI-Frank Bloom passed away on May 18, 2023, six weeks shy of his 99th birthday. He was born in

Cincinnati, Ohio and lived there his entire life, with the exception of three years during World

War II when he was stationed in Greenland and Iceland while serving in the US Army Air Corps.

Frank was preceded in death by his Walnut Hills High School sweetheart, Ann (Heilbrun)

Bloom, to whom he was married for 38 years, and his second wife, Rosemary (Heldman)

Bloom, to whom he was married for 37 years. He is survived by children Barby (Don) Cohen,

Bob Bloom (Alison Kamine), and Andrew (Alison) Bloom; grandchildren Amy Cohen (Guy

Zuzovsky), Lori Cohen (Michael Brochner), Lena (Josh) Hershkovitz, Jacob Bloom (Evelyn

Nelson), Adam Bloom, and Jeremy Bloom; and 7 great grandchildren!

Frank worked for 43 years at The Cino Company, the flavor business founded by his

father, Ralph Bloom. Both of his sons later joined him in that business. He was an enthusiastic participant in his Saturday morning golf game with longtime friends, he appreciated a well-made very dry martini, and he always 'ate light' before his Thursday evening candle pin bowling games at The Wyoming Civic Center. He and Ann were founding members of The Cincinnati School for Judaism that later became Valley Temple. He traveled the world with Rosemary and loved experiencing other cultures.

Frank was a dedicated patron of the arts. He loved and supported the Cincinnati Symphony, Playhouse in the Park, and many other local arts organizations. He also served on the boards of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation and the Losantiville Country Club. He supported Planned Parenthood, the MS Society, and Crayons to Computers. Frank also served for several years on the Citizens Advisory Committee of the Wyoming School Board.
