A lover of fashion, parties, cooking and fun, Helen Greenberg, 95, died of natural causes in Cincinnati, Ohio on August 23, 2025.

Helen was born in New Orleans, LA in 1929 to Morris and Rose Rosenzweig. An assertive woman who knew what she wanted, Helen attended LSU on a scholarship, despite her parents' protests, where she majored in Merchandising. Helen loved fashion and her training at Neiman Marcus in Dallas.

Helen moved to Jackson, Mississippi in 1957 when she married Jackson Attorney Marvin A. Cohen. She worked as a secretary to the Dean of University of Mississippi Medical Center. Helen was also an active volunteer with Jackson Interfaith Fellowship, PTA and Beth Israel Congregation. In 1969, Helen became a real estate agent and later a broker, as she grew her business, becoming one of the first women to transition into commercial real estate to include leasing up the new Capital Tower Building, the McRae's office conversion, among many others in downtown Jackson.

Helen married Rob Greenberg, the love of her life, in 1977. They loved to travel, dance and socialize with their many friends and family. Helen was a lifelong lover of tennis, bridge, and gourmet cooking.

Helen was preceded in death by her loving husband, Rob and his son, Mark (Barbara) Greenberg. Helen is survived by her daughters, Marcy Cohen, Laurie (Neil) Dubin, and Jill Greenberg (Mark) Mason.
