



## Ivan Gartenlaub

Ivan Gartenlaub was born on September 19, 1935, and died on June 21, 2023. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife Irene (nee' Shapiro) and his brother Alfred (Barbara). He is survived by his brother Marshall (Patricia), his sons Fred Gartenlaub (Andrea Beck), Keith Gartenlaub (Tess), and his granddaughter Lily Plum.
