June 13, 1920 - July 21, 2022

Joan Claire Scheineson passed away on July 21, 2022, ultimately from the effects of COVID, still fighting for more time at the age of 102. Joan Scheineson noted frequently with pride, that her mother, Roslyn Weil Klein, lived to be 105 under her care. Joan lived her long and happy life modestly, graciously, generously, and unselfishly. She took great interest in others and was devoted to her mother, deceased husband, Julian (a City of Cincinnati Traffic Engineer), and her twin sons Irwin (Denise) of Sarasota, FL and Marc (Cathy) of McLean, VA. Joan was an avid bridge player through her later years which she attributed to her long life, sharp mind and accurate memory. She volunteered in the community for causes including the Wise Temple Sisterhood (Chaired the Youth, Education and Special Projects Fund which she took over from her mother), the Boy Scouts of America, her children's schools and social welfare organizations. She was an early female graduate of Western College for Women in Oxford, OH (now part of Miami University). Prior to her marriage to Julian in 1954, Joan worked at Cincinnati Jewish Hospital as a medical laboratory technician, and as a "Rosie the Riveter" helping build aircraft and jet engines at General Electric in Evandale. She leaves behind devoted grandchildren including: Kate McCorry (Michael) in Denver, CO; John in Madison, WI; Andrew (Nilda) in Arlington, VA; Sara Karerat (Ryan) in Brooklyn, NY; Ellis Krienik (Carol) in Chicago, IL and Benjamin Krienik in Houston, TX. Great grandchildren include: Maxwell and Willa McCorry in Denver, CO.

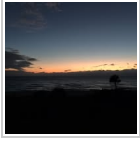
