CINCINNATI- Clayton, Marilyn B., age 71, passed away April 11, 2025. Ms. Clayton was considered a pioneer in her field of nursing. She received her Master of Science degree in Nursing from Pace University, New York in 1978. She worked primarily as a woman's health-care nurse practitioner for over 30 years. Half of her career was spent in Cocoa Beach, Florida where she started, owned and operated a women's healthcare private practice. Ms. Clayton's passion was to empower and educate women so they could participate in decisions regarding their own healthcare. She also served as the Florida Nurses Association legislative delegate and worked diligently to broaden the scope of practice of nurse practitioners in Florida.

When not working, Marilyn was an avid traveler who loved planning international trips, exploring new cultures and going on African safaris. She also was a passionate animal lover, especially horses. Besides donating to various animal charities, she also worked as a volunteer at the Brevard Zoo in Melbourne, Florida.

Marilyn is preceded in death by parents, Arthur and Shirley Clayton and former husband Walter Springer. She is survived by her longtime partner, Michael Ouellette, her sister Marcia Clayton Besso (Bruce) and nieces and nephews.

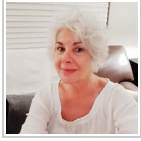
