I know that God ultimately saved me but He used Dr. Gladson to get me through all the pain and the annorexia I was trying to overcome and so I did!! Love to all of his family and friends! He made a huge difference in numerous lives! I am just one example of a life whole again mentally, emotionally and physically and Spiritually!!
