CINCINNATI-Reuel Dolnick Ash, age 65, of Cincinnati, passed away June 25, 2022 while in hospice care for glioblastoma. Reuel was born on May 1, 1957 in Chicago, Illinois. He graduated from Stanford University in 1979 and went on to obtain a Master in Music from Eastman School of Music, followed by a Juris Doctor from the University of Cincinnati College of Law. A specialist in bankruptcy and commercial litigation, he practiced law at several area firms, and was most recently a partner at Ulmer & Berne. He served as program chair and board president for Chamber Music Cincinnati. He was a brilliant and multitalented man whose days (and often nights) were animated by the study of music and history. He could improvise a fugue at the piano, or, for a lucky few, an irreverent birthday song in the style of a jazz standard. He often left an indelible impression on those he met, and during his illness his spirits were buoyed by the many letters and visits from his friends from across the years. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends for his keen wit and loving kindness. He is survived by his wife of 23 years, Linda; his brother Avner (Rosemary); his sister Miriam; his former wife, Drake Crittenden Ash, and their children: Daniel (Ryoko); Sarah (Toni); and Emily; his step-daughter Kendra (Chris) and granddaughter Sloane; and his nieces Alexandra (Mickey) and Elisheva. He was preceded in death by his father, Milton, and his mother, Shulamite. There will be a public visitation at Weil-Kahn Funeral Home, 8350 Cornell Rd., Cinti, OH 45249 on Tuesday, June 28 from 9:30-11:00 A.M. ,
