



## Robert I. Lemlich

August 22, 1926 - May 12, 2016

LEMLICH, Robert, age 89, passed away May 12, 2016, born August 22, 1926, preceded in death by his parents Dr. Marcus S. Lemlich and Mary Marcus Lemlich, his wife Elizabeth Ann (nee Murphy) Lemlich and his brother Benjamin Lemlich. Robert attended two Yeshivas for Hebrew Elementary Education in Crown Heights and Flatbusch, NY. Bob began his college career at the age of 16 and was drafted into the Navy at 18 in 1944 during WWII where he served until 1946. Bob graduated Summa Cum Laude in 1948 with a Bachelor's Degree in Chemical Engineering from New York University. He received his Masters from the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn in 1951 and his PhD in Philosophy in Chemical Engineering in 1954. Became a licensed Engineer in the state of NY in 1955 and in OH in 1956. He taught Chemical Engineering at the University of Cincinnati from 1952 until his retirement in 1985. Bob was a lifetime member of Mensa and he was a Fellow of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers and the American Assn. for the Advancement of Science. He was also a member of the American Chemical Society. Bob was a member of Etz Chaim Congregation.
