CINCINNATI – Ronald A. Swartz, age 88, passed away on Sunday, November 15, 2020, less than 20 hours before his beloved wife, Rona Swartz. Ron was born in Far Rockaway, New York on September 6, 1932. He was the devoted husband of his beloved wife Rona Swartz (nee Pomerantz). He became an accomplished musician, was a member of the United States Air Force Band stationed in Fairbanks, Alaska during the Korean war, and played clarinet and saxophone in several Big Bands that entertained large numbers of people in concerts and recorded jazz music. After his honorable discharge from the Air Force, he attended NYU on the GI Bill, and graduated with a degree in accounting. He worked as an accountant for many years, rising to be Controller of two large corporations. Ron had many interests throughout his life including photography, tennis, exercising, drawing, abstract art, and listening to symphonies and Big Band music. He was the editor-in-chief of the bulletin of the Bay Shore Jewish Center, New York, for many years. Devoted and proud father of Dani (Erik) Zander, Melissa (Robert) Kaplan, and Shari (Dovid) Imbo.
