March 18, 1934 - January 4, 2026

Rosa Healey "Bubbe" Olson (née Adelsztain), age 91, passed away peacefully on January 4, 2026, in Cincinnati, Ohio. Born on March 18, 1934, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Rosa lived a life marked by dedication to family, service to her community, and a vibrant spirit that touched all who knew her. Rosa earned her bachelor's degree in accounting in Buenos Aires before immigrating to the United States. In 1974, she began a distinguished career with the Princeton City School District in Ohio. Over the next 24 years, she served with diligence and integrity as an accountant and treasurer until her retirement in 1998. Retirement did not slow Rosa down; she continued to share her expertise through independent tax consulting and work with a local tax service before retiring a second time. A devoted mother, Rosa dedicated her life to raising her two sons. Her love for children extended beyond her own family -after retiring from professional work, she volunteered with For The Babies and later with Loving Hands For Babies. Through these organizations, she lovingly knitted and crocheted baby outfits and afghans for premature infants, donating them to local hospitals. Her hands were rarely still; whether crafting gifts for newborns or creating cherished items for loved ones, Rosa's handiwork was an enduring symbol of her care. Rosa found joy in many pursuits. She was an enthusiastic participant in water aerobics classes at the Mercy Healthplex and enjoyed quiet moments reading or playing video games. A passionate sports fan, she followed football, hockey, golf, mixed martial arts, and never missed an episode of Wheel of Fortune or Jeopardy.

She cheered faithfully for the Cincinnati Reds and Bengals as well as The Ohio State Buckeyes. She will be deeply missed by her son Paul (Amanda) Healey of Maineville, Ohio; daughter-in-law Amy Healey of Blue Ash, Ohio; grandchildren Sarah (Simon) Amor, Alexis Healey, Levi Healey; Sean and Stephanie Healey; Aidan and Evan Callahan; and great-grandchildren Norah and David Amor ("Little David") and Kylie Keller. Rosa also leaves behind nieces Gloria (Alan) Nadler of New Jersey and Paulette (Mark) Ettinger of New York; great-nephews Jordan (Mya) Nadler, Sam (Sarah) Nadler, David Nadler; and great-niece Lydia Ettinger.
