Susan L. Brant (Litvak) passed away at the age of 71, on January 25, 2023 at her home in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Suzi was the beloved wife of Bob, loving mother of Abbie (Neal), Vallie (Chris), and Jordan (Tory), cherished sister of Judi Roth, proud grandmother of Sloane, Reid, Harper, Ryan, and Brant, and a devoted Aunt and Great Aunt.

Born in Cincinnati, Ohio on August 24, 1951 to the late Rhea (Steinberg) and Sidney Litvak, Suzi was a proud Walnut Hills alumna (class of 1969) and settled in her hometown after her marriage in 1974 to raise her family. She chose to focus on motherhood full time after working as a dental hygienist, and she continued her duties as Mimi to her five grandchildren as well as weekly breakfasts with two of her great nieces.

Suzi liked to bookend her days with cups of coffee (usually starting at Bob Evans). In between, she was a dedicated volunteer with the Jewish Federation of Cincinnati, especially in the Women's Philanthropy division, often alongside her twin sister Judi, where she visited Cuba and Eastern Europe as part of educational and philanthropic travel initiatives.

She loved to travel, as close as Saugatuck, Michigan and as far as Europe and Israel with friends and family alike. When at home in Cincinnati, she could

be found playing spirited games of Canasta, hosting family gatherings, watching cooking shows, and exploring all the food, arts, and activities that Cincinnati has to offer. Her laughter and energy will be greatly missed.
