(KOREA) Falberg, Warren C., age 80, passed away Saturday, November 10, 2018 at The Hospice of Cincinnati. Mr. Falberg suffered a stroke on October 23, 2018. He then had a seizure 10 days later that led to his eventual decline. Always a fighter, Mr. Falberg beat lung cancer, pneumonia, and a bleeding ulcer all in 2018. He is survived by his beloved wife of 53 years, Irene, his son Rob, daughter Lara and her partner, Jason, daughter Andrea, son-in-law Bob, and granddaughter Lila. Mr. Falberg was born on December 14th, 1937 in New York City. He graduated from the High School of Music and Art in Manhattan. Falberg went on to achieve his Master's degree in hospital administration from Columbia University. Mr. Falberg was the former V.P. of Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. He was then recruited by The Jewish Hospital of Cincinnati to become the President and CEO in 1976. He held this position until 1998 and went on to serve as the President and CEO of Visiting Nurse Association of Greater Cincinnati and N. Kentucky from 1999 through 2012. Falberg sat on various boards throughout his career and was awarded numerous accolades. His recognition for community service included the Martin Luther King Jr. Spirit Award and the Lifetime Achievement Health Care Heroes Award. He taught at The University of Cincinnati, Xavier, The Wharton School of Business, and Northern Kentucky University providing mentoring and knowledge to students going into the hospital administration field. First Lieutenant Falberg served in the United States Army for three years, stationed
